History buffs & backcountry explorers - Own a 1 br/1 bath cabin from Dubois' Area Tie Hack History! The tie hacks were Scandinavian woodsmen who lived in the surrounding mountains from the 1910's -1940's, cutting down trees and hacking them into railroad ties, then floating the ties down the Wind River to Riverton, 80 miles distant, to the tie yard there. Many people today hike into the backcountry in search of remnants from this by-gone era. Sections of flumes & some cabins in our area still stand as a testament to these rugged, hard-working men. This cabin is one of the last of its kind. There are beautiful views of the Wind River Mountains.
